

How?

Evaluate these 5 criteria:

1. Reduced nasal polyp size (≥ 1)
2. Reduced need for OCS/salvage surgery
3. Improved quality of life (SNOT-22 < 40+ improvement > MCID)
4. Improved sense of smell (hyposmic by semi-objective smell test)
5. Reduced impact of comorbidities (defined by MCID for specific type 2 disease test)

Good –Excellent response
4-5 criteria

Moderate response
2-3 criteria

No response
0-1 criteria

Evaluate treatment response after 6 months



Re-evaluate before continuing:

- Reconsider diagnosis
- Identify treatable traits

Evaluate treatment response after 12 months



Consider:

- Discontinuing/switching biologic
- Salvage surgery (covered by biologic)

Continue treatment and monitor

SNOT-22: Sino-Nasal Outcome Test, MCID: Minimum Clinically Important Difference
